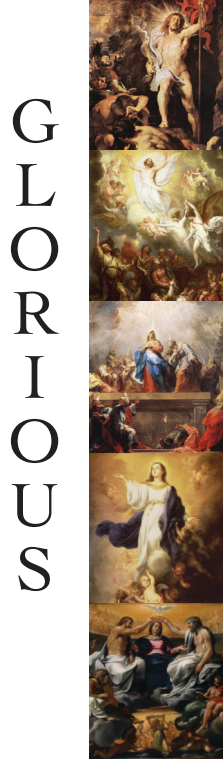

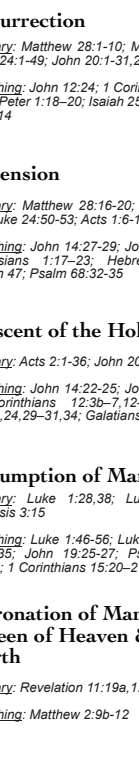

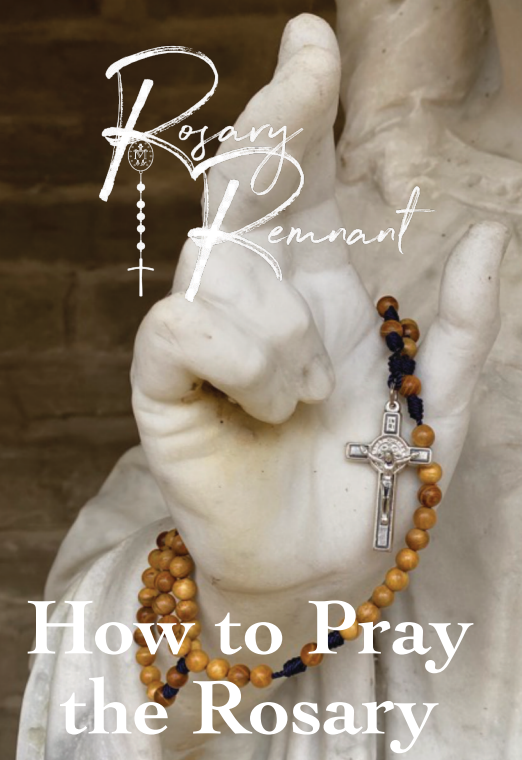
Steps

1. Begin by making the Sign of the Cross while holding the crucifix. Pray the Apostles' Creed.
2. Pray an Our Father.
3. Pray a Hail Mary on each of the three beads, asking for an increase in the Theological Virtues of Faith, Hope and Charity (Love).
4. Pray the Glory Be.
5. Announce or call to mind the first Mystery to meditate upon and pray an Our Father.
6. Pray one Hail Mary on each of the ten beads
7. Finish the decade by praying a Glory Be and the Fatima Prayer. (**Note:** steps 5-7 together are called a decade).
8. Repeat steps 5-7 for the next four decades, meditating on the remaining Mysteries.



9. Holding the center piece, pray the Hail, Holy Queen and the concluding Rosary prayer. Finish by making the Sign of the Cross.

Rosary Prayers



The Sign Of The Cross

In the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit. Amen. (Note: Make cross by touching with right hand — forehead [Father], torso [Son], left shoulder [Holy], right shoulder [Spirit])

Apostles Creed

I believe in God, the Father almighty, Creator of heaven and earth, and in Jesus Christ, his only Son, our Lord, who was conceived by the Holy Spirit, born of the Virgin Mary, suffered under Pontius Pilate, was crucified, died, and was buried; he descended into hell, on the third day he rose again from the dead; he ascended into heaven, and is seated at the right hand of God the Father almighty; from there he will come to judge the living and the dead. I believe in the Holy Spirit, the holy catholic Church, the communion of saints, the forgiveness of sins, the resurrection of the body, and life everlasting. Amen.

Our Father

Our Father, who art in heaven; hallowed be Thy name; Thy kingdom come; Thy will be done on earth as it is in heaven. Give us this day our daily bread; and forgive us our trespasses as we forgive those who trespass against us; and lead us not into temptation; but deliver us from evil. Amen.

O God, whose only begotten Son, by His life, death, and resurrection, has purchased for us the rewards of eternal life, grant, we beseech Thee, that meditating upon these Mysteries of the Most Holy Rosary of the Blessed Virgin Mary, we may imitate what they contain and obtain what they promise, through the same Christ Our Lord. Amen.

Glory be to the Father, and to the Son, and to the Holy Spirit. As it was in the beginning, is now, and ever shall be, world without end. Amen.

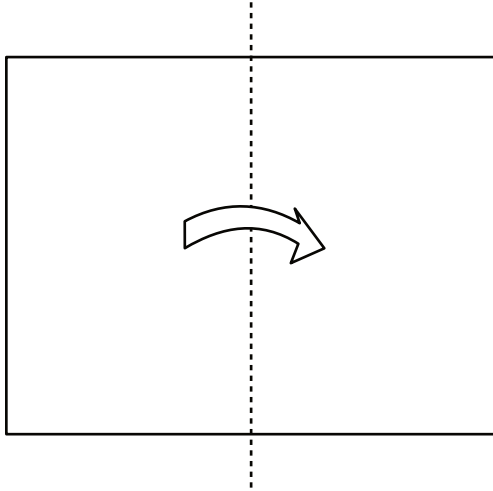
Our Father

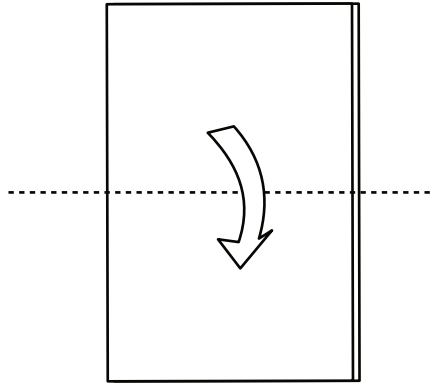
Hail Mary

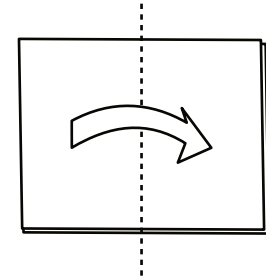
Folding Instructions



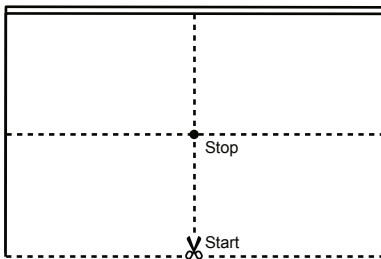
Step 1 Fold paper in half in the middle of long edge of the paper



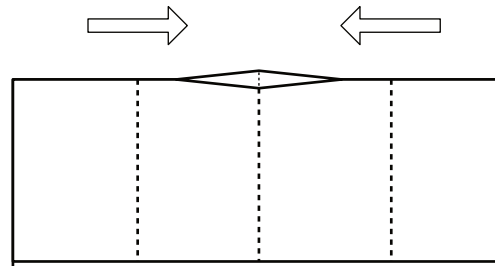
Step 2 Fold the paper in half again in a downward direction



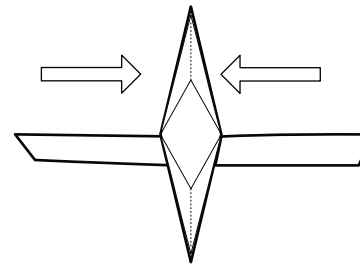
Step 3 Fold the paper in half one more time as shown. The paper should be folded to one-eighth of the original size.



Step 4 Unfold the paper to half the original size and turn the paper so the paper is open at top and the crease is at the bottom (the dotted lines represent the creases). Cut from the bottom of the paper to the middle (from the START to the STOP points shown above).

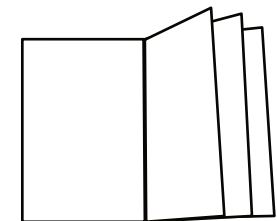


Side View

Step 5 Unfold the paper completely and refold in half along the short edge as shown. Push the paper inward so that the inside faces touch. It will look like a “plus sign” (+) if done correctly. The creases should form a booklet spine along the left edge.
